

Does the student:	<b>Identify any real or potential physical hazards?</b>
	<b>Minimise immediate risk to self and ensure the health and safety of him/her and others</b>
	<b>Understand procedures that identify new employees that need to be advised on the safety procedures associated with emergency, fire and evacuation in the work place</b>
	<b>Identify the following:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Emergency alarms and emergency procedures at the workplace</li> <li>➤ Emergency situations or potential emergencies in the workplace</li> </ul>
	<b>Have an understanding of the following:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Location of emergency equipment in the workplace</li> <li>➤ Procedures for reporting emergencies in the workplace</li> <li>➤ When emergency evacuation is required and the assembly area post evacuation</li> <li>➤ Circumstances when evacuation plans might need to be modified</li> <li>➤ The roles, responsibilities and the authority of the personnel responsible for the evacuation</li> <li>➤ The need to assist others that may require assistance in the emergency situation</li> </ul>
	<b>Have an understanding of the roles and responsibilities of emergency personnel:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Demonstrate knowledge of the fire control system</li> <li>➤ Knowledge of equipments such as hats, armbands, vests, distinctive clothing</li> </ul>
Student must display the ability to:	<b>Look for hazards and risks associated with emergencies. They emergencies could include:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Fire, flood, earthquake, severe weather, storm damage, industrial accident,</li> <li>➤ Bomb threat, hostage situation, armed invasion, letter bomb, biological agent</li> <li>➤ Medical emergency, transport accident, civil disorder, animal or live stock emergency</li> </ul>
	<b>Effectively communicate in an emergency situation. Oral communication skills should include:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Asking questions to ensure safe operation</li> <li>➤ Providing clear instructions</li> <li>➤ Listening to and understanding workplace instructions</li> <li>➤ Recognising the need for competence in English, or a community language depending of the client group</li> </ul>
Student should have the knowledge to:	<b>Demonstrate essential practical skills such as:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Raise the alarm as per workplace procedures</li> <li>➤ Follow control organisations directions</li> <li>➤ Alert /assist others in your area and evacuate the area to the assembly point</li> <li>➤ Source safe evacuation route and modify route if circumstances change</li> </ul>
